There are glossy websites and booklets about how to complete your doctoral degree or advance your postdoc career in Germany (even a few in English); some of them are actually very good (e.g. the "Research in Germany" series). But very often a lot of necessary implicit knowledge is missing: knowledge which is known to most professional actors and stakeholders, but not spelled out (sometimes because these truths have a "politically incorrect" ring to them or are open to conflicting interpretations) and thus often remains unknown to those new to the field, including incoming or visiting doctoral and postdoctoral researchers.

This event will try to close this information gap by providing answers to the following questions:

- What are the preconditions for a successful doctoral project in Germany?
- What are the options for financing a doctoral project in Germany?
- How does a doctoral project work in the various disciplines?
- What are the possibilities for employment within the university system and outside of it in Germany?
- How can one make a success of an academic career beyond the doctorate in Germany?
- How does the German system with its career paths compare to other academic systems?

There will be a short presentation of essential points followed by a discussion of participants' questions.
